

HIGHLIGHTS OF SCHOOL YEAR 2009-10

Our art students at Covenant Christian School were blessed with many school, community, regional and national opportunities throughout 2009/2010:

104 art students representing Covenant Christian School were named in various news articles.

Our art students were able to work with 4 professional artists 6 times throughout the previous year. Our guest artists last year, included Ibiyinka Alao, the United Nations Artist of Year & Nigerian Art Ambassador; Tres Taylor, an international artist from Birmingham; Nancy Raia, Community Outreach Director from the Eastern Shore Art Center in Fairhope; and Ricky Trione, the regional famed inspirational blind artist.

Last year our school exhibited a total of 1274 pieces of student artwork. 846 within the school and an amazing 428 pieces of student art were exhibited not only locally but also traveled as a part of the nationally acclaimed "Traveling Pants Show - The Alabama Initiative".
